Accessible, Affordable Quality Childcare- are these still our most important priorities?

- -IQ4K will be rolling out so we will asterisk where it says QRS Level 3
- -Still need more providers-issue at centers is staffing (room for more kids but can't find enough staff)
- -What happens to number of childcare slots? Childcare bills may have made it through legis. Some bills will pass-as of today hard to say which will pass.
- -Increase number of qualified, educated providers/slots

Accessible, Affordable Quality Preschools-

- -keep same
- asterisk where it says QRS Level 3

Healthy Children- add children's mental health, all other still relevant. Access to dental care and children's mental health- realign the bullets:

- -Dental care
- -Mental Health
- -Medical home/Medical insurance
- -Confirmed/Founded Child Abuse
- -Children screened for dev delay
- -births to mothers under age 20 (Remove *)

Discussed QRS Ratings

- -5 active providers (1 home, 2 centers, 1 head start, 1 preschool in Holstein Wee Wisdom)
- -Extended deadlines

- -Mandatory registration-would be good, we have many unregistered daycares in Ida Co.
- -Raise number from 5 to 7 is in the works (Bailey)

SHIP received notification that they have been Redesignated as ECI Area Board Petition board-- 3,4, or 5 year RFP (instead of every 2 years)

1. Accessible, Affordable Quality Child Care

2. Accessible, Affordable Quality Preschool

- √ % of all providers are QPPS-verified, Head Start standards
- √ % of preschoolers ready for kindergarten

√ # of quality slots available for 3-year-olds

3. Healthy Children*

- √ # of children receiving dental screens prior to kindergarten
- √ % of children whose mental health is being prioritized Ida Co. Committee recommended to establish a baseline of what type of data is being collected for infant and early childhood mental health to create a better understanding of what needs to be collected in the future
- √ % of families with a medical home / medical insurance
- ✓ incidence (rate per thousand) of confirmed/founded child abuse (age 0 –
 5)
- √ % of children screened for developmental delays that are referred on for additional services
- √ % of births to mothers under age 20
