Committee spent the entire meeting speaking about Community Priorities and Indicators:

## 1. Accessible, Affordable Quality Child Care

- % of providers with QRS Level 3 or higher (\* will be revisited once IQ4K, the new quality rating system is launched) WC Committee approved the Ida Co. recommendation to add an asterisk regarding the upcoming rollout of the IO4K
- √ % of regulated programs / providers
- √ % of average median income that parents pay for child care
- # of (useable slots) operational capacity WC Committee updated this indicator to reflect actual "usable slots" not what the child care is DHS licensed for

## 2. Accessible, Affordable Quality Preschool

- √ % of providers with QRS Level 3 or higher (\* will be revisited once IQ4K, the new quality rating system is launched) WC Committee approved the Ida Co. recommendation to add an asterisk regarding the upcoming rollout of the IQ4K
- √ % of all providers that are QPPS-verified, Head Start standards
- √ % of preschoolers ready for kindergarten
- √ # of quality slots available for 3-year-olds

## 3. Healthy Children\*

  Committee approved the Ida Co. Committee recommendation to establish
  a baseline of what type of data is being collected for infant and early
  childhood mental health to create a better understanding of what needs
  to be collected in the future
- √ % of families with a medical home
- % of families with medical insurance WC Committee reversed the Ida Co. recommendation to combine medical home & medical insurance and separated them to their original separate indicators
- √ incidence (rate per thousand) of confirmed/founded child abuse (age 0 −
  5)
- √ % of children screened for developmental delays that are referred on for additional services
- % of births to mothers under age 20
  WC Committee approved the Ida Co. recommendation to place these indicators in this specific order of priority
