This model acts as a safe and sober location for a patient to go to once medically cleared by ED or hospital. Once cleared they would go to the facility for an evaluation, treatment recommendations, outpatient level of care, meetings, etc. until a bed could be open for inpatient care. Patients at the facility would remain there and firm structure and rules would need to be in place to ensure this facility does not become another revolving door.2. Proposed staffing model includes: on call ARNP, 3 RN's, 2 care coordinators (BSW/RN), 5 chemical dependency/mental health providers3. Kelsey and Megan worked together to set a proposed budget. We had some last minute quotes come through and those will be added prior to sending out. Best guess this will be around 1 million per year operating.
