SHIP put out an RFP for financial audit services after being notified by the previous auditers that they would be unable to proceed with the contract extension this year due to staffing issues.

Two firms submitted applications: Eide Bailly of Sioux Falls and Nichols, Rise & Company, L.L.P. The applications were evaluated by the Executive Director, the Finance Director, the Programs Director and two members of the Accounting staff. Each application was evaluated and scored based on four criteria. Average score for Eide Bailly was 93 points out of 100. Average score for Nichols, Rise & Company was 88. The evaluation committee recommended awarding the contract to Eide Bailly based on the higher average score.

SUBJECT: Transfer of Juvenile Court Services FY23 State Funds to Woodbury County/Siouxland Human Investment Partnership (SHIP) Decategorization Project This letter proposes to transfer FY23 Second Designation State funds from the following Juvenile Court Services funding stream to the Woodbury County/Siouxland Human Investment Partnership (SHIP) Decat Project, subject to acceptance by the Decat Project Governance Board of any special conditions/limitations outlined below.

\$135,000.00 State FJ00 from Court-ordered Services

\$190,000.00 State F0S2 from Life Skills

Total Transfer Amount = \$325,000.00

Special Conditions/Limitations: If funds are not fully expended, they shall carryover with the same designation. These funds shall be spent no later than June 30, 2026. Transferred funds are designated as follows:

\$101,846.95 for FFT (DCAT 20-011)

\$145,276.03 for Tracking and Monitoring (DCAT 20-008)

\$48,041.02 for Education Transition (DCAT 23-024)

\$13,586.00 for Education Technical Assistance (DCAT 18-032)

\$16,250.00 for Decat Coordination service to ensure responsible fiscal management

Please note that there may be the possibility of additional funds available to be transferred. Should that occur, I will send you another letter outlining the terms and conditions for those additional funds.

Partnership (SHIP) Decat Governance Board. We agree to abide by the special conditions/limitations specified above regarding these funds.
